

Reach Students Central District Training Scholarships

The nature and purpose of RSCD training Scholarships

One of the better ways to achieve the purpose* of RSCD is to equip and train Free Church youth workers to more effectively reach and disciple students. In order to assist with that training we are committed to providing tuition assistance for several strategic opportunities. We desire that this training will assist youth workers as they develop disciple making youth ministries in their churches.

Eligibility for RSCD Training Scholarships

Applicants must be currently working (either volunteer or paid) with students in an Evangelical Free Church in the Central District and their church must have actively participated in Impact or Winter Blast retreats in the previous 12 months (or intends to participate in the coming year). Special accommodations may be made for applicants who meaningfully contribute to RSCD's mission.

A volunteer youth worker is eligible only if there is no paid youth worker in his or her church.

The Scope of RSCD Training Scholarships

Scholarships are available for the registration cost of approved trainings (not to include food, lodging or travel). Approved trainings include events sponsored by Sonlife, Cadre, EFCA, Purpose Driven Youth Ministry training.

How to Apply for a Scholarship

Submit a completed application to the RSCD Chairman before the stated deadlines.

Funding for the CDSM Training Scholarships

- Rebound: Funding for Rebound is guaranteed (up to \$299/couple; \$399/first time couple).
- Applications must be received by the date of the training event. Allow 4 weeks for processing.
- The maximum amount provided for a qualified applicant in a given ministry year is \$400; to be used exclusively for approved training events.

Procedures for Disbursement of the RSCD Training Scholarships

Once applications have been received the available funds will be dispersed in the following manner.

1. Other than for Rebound, the Support Team will determine the amounts to be dispersed to each applicant.
2. Checks will be made out to the training organization or applicant's church and mailed to the applicant.
3. If the check is made out to the training organization, the applicant should forward the RSCD check to the training agency and remit a receipt to the CDSM treasurer.
